GLOBETROTTERS OF TENNIS COME TO REYNOLDS PLANTATION

Greensboro, Ga. (September 6, 2007) – Linger Longer Communities welcomed the Peter Burwash International (PBI) Tennis Show to Reynolds Plantation. Often described as the “Harlem Globetrotters of Tennis,” the show brought five players to the Lake Club to display feats of athleticism, sportsmanship and plenty of tennis tips and laughter. Over 160 tennis fans attended the August 11th show.

“The PBI Tennis Show was a lot of fun; we knew it would be an extravaganza,” says Dave Neuhart, director of tennis at Reynolds Plantation. “It’s the kind of performance that will get anyone excited about tennis. Tennis is hot once again.”

The performers demonstrated strokes and volleying – all while using skits and costumes to get the point, and the ball, across. They illustrated different serves and used their humor to show the strategy of playing singles, doubles and mixed doubles.
