**NAMING OF NEW COURSE CONTINUES TO HONOR
DISTINCTIVE TRADITION AND TERRAIN OF REYNOLDS PLANTATION**

Greensboro, Ga. (February 23, 2006) – The legacy of the land that is Reynolds Plantation is to be further enhanced with the formal naming of its newest golf course as The Creek Club, in honor of the heritage of the Creek tribe that once inhabited the region, as well as to reflect the character of the band of water that inhabits the property.

Featuring a par 72 designed by prominent golf course architect Jim Engh, The Creek Club is to be the first private golf facility at Reynolds Plantation. Scheduled to open in the spring of 2007, The Creek Club will be the fifth golf course at Reynolds Plantation, bringing the total to 99 holes of golf laid out along the shores of Lake Oconee, each course named in respect for its historical relationships.

“This area has a rich connection with the history and culture of the Creek people,” said Bob Mauragas, vice president of golf for Reynolds Plantation. “This name for the new golf course is a tribute to the past, which is very important to everyone at Reynolds Plantation, and provides a perfect link to the present. Combined with the manner in which the water curves its way through the golf course, The Creek Club is absolutely ideal name.”

The Creek Club, which is to be available only to members and their guests, will add to the legacy of world-class golf at Reynolds Plantation, which already boasts award-winning layouts designed by some of the greatest architects in the business – Jack Nicklaus, Tom Fazio, Rees Jones and Bob Cupp – and has been ranked among the “Top Destinations In The World” by *Golf Digest*.

The Creek Club is to play from 4,805 yards to 7,125 yards, with Engh designing a combination of four to five tees per hole. Natural creeks appear in varying dimensions along the way, ranging from a mild stream to a more dramatic chasm, running up against 14 of the holes. On the par-3 13th, the creek spills into a cove that creates a water carry from tee to green.

“I can’t tell you how excited we are to see this golf course come together,” said Engh, named 2003 Architect of the Year by *Golf Digest*. “Each nine is going to have

three par 4s, three par 5s and three par 3s, which gives the course a flow that matches the diverse natural habitat. And generally, on the back nine, the more variety you have, the better finish.”
